# SHUNTER DRIVER TRAINING

## INTRODUCTION

This course is intended for all personnel who may be required to move vehicles on your premises. It will also equip them with the necessary skills to be competent and safe in their duties.

Additionally, it has been designed to be in compliance with the employer's duties to provide adequate safety training under Section 2 (2)c of the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974 and subsequent amendments but will be carried out by a D.S.A. registered instructor.

## CONTENT

- Driving licence checks – medical
- Conditions Daily vehicle checks e.g. oil,
- Fuel, water etc. Mechanical checks e.g. air brakes
- Familiarisation with vehicle
- Enter and exit vehicle safely
- Safety techniques and fault-finding
- Hands-on practical training
- Observation of speed limits
- Reversing techniques for sighted/ blind side and confined spaces
- Awareness of other vehicles in the vicinity
- Coupling and uncoupling (where

appropriate)

- Banksman Signalling
- Specialised site elements

## DURATION

Varies from one to two days dependant on the attendee's experience.

## ATTENDANCE

Aimed at all personnel whose duties would include shunting. If the movement of Company vehicles is restricted to private land it may not be necessary for the trainees to hold an LGV licence. However, you should first check with your insurers to ascertain their requirements.

4 candidates per course.

## AVAILABILITY

Dates, times and venue can be arranged to suit your particular requirements and work environment, an additional charge will be made if training is required out of the hours of 08.00 - 17.00 hours Monday - Friday.

## DOCUMENTATION

Upon successful completion individual certificates will be issued as evidence of formal training.
